- The candidate belonging to GEN and OBC categories require an aggregate of at least 70% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (PCM) in the qualifying examination (10+2 or equivalent) and those belonging to SC/ST/PD should have an aggregate of at least 60% marks in PCM subjects in the QE.
- To gualify for ISAT-2012, the year of first appearance in the QE of the candidates should be 2011 or 2012.
